2018 Conditions

- All Iowa Sires Stakes Nominations are due postmarked by Thursday, March 15, 2018.**
- A two-year-old does not have to make nomination payments or start to be eligible to race as a three-year-old.
- Annual Membership Fee is \$10 All horse owners listed per the USTA must be members of the Iowa Sires Stakes Association. If a horse is sold after nominations are paid and the purchaser is not already a member, he/she must pay a membership fee. There will be no family memberships.
- If an owner is found not to be a 2018 member of the Iowa Sires Stakes Association a penalty of \$30 will be assessed, in addition to the regular \$10 membership fee. The penalty and fee must be paid before the colt may start.
- All owners must be 2018 USTA members and each horse must have current USTA eligibility.
- The total purses for Iowa Sired races at each race meet will not exceed \$72,000, All feature races will have equal purses not to exceed \$6,000. NW\$3,000/AE Claiming races will have purses equaling 25% of the feature races, not to exceed \$1,500.
- Purse monies will be divided for the first five places as follows: 45-25-15-10-5%. If less than five starters enter, purse money will be distributed according to USTA rules.
- Season trophies will go to the highest point colt and highest point filly in each division. Points given as follows:
 - 1st place – 10pts
 - 2nd place – 6pts
 - 3rd place – 4pts
 - 4th place – 3pts
 - 5th place – 2ptsNo points will be awarded for the NW\$3,000/AE Claiming races.
- Definition: All stallions and geldings will be called colts and all mares will be called fillies.
- Fillies and colts will race in separate divisions. When there are four divisions or less, uneven fields between colts and fillies may be carded including less than five starters. There may be a mixed division if the separation of fillies and colts results in more than four divisions. In the event of a mixed division, fillies will draw the inside post positions.
- Coupled entries will be allowed based on common ownership only. No coupled entries based on trainer or management will be allowed. It is the responsibility of the person entering the horse to indicate if the horse is an "ENTRY." Failure to do so will not be a cause for a re-draw. Coupled entries in a race must include **ALL** horses with common ownership in each division.
- In the event of an ENTRY of two horses of the same sex, only one can be drawn into a mixed division of the opposite sex
- Any horse entered in an Iowa Sires Stakes 2 or 3-year-old feature race which shows the last two consecutive charted lines as distanced by greater than 30 lengths will be placed in the last post position.
- NW \$3,000/AE CLAIMING \$2,500 PACERS or \$4,000 TROTTERS WITH NO ALLOWANCES IN 2018: Each class at Iowa Sire's Stakes Association meets will have a division(s) for the NW \$3,000/AE Claiming \$2,500 pacers or \$4,000 trotters. The purse for each of these races will equal 25% of the feature races, not to exceed \$1,500. Mixed divisions will be permitted and the rules for splits will be the same as for the overnight races. A minimum of 4 entries are required or the race will not be held. In the event the race is not held, horses entered will automatically be moved to the feature race, unless different instructions are given at the time of entry.
- As a condition of nominating to the Iowa Sires Stakes Association races, participants agree to pre- or post-race blood and/or urine testing on horses competing in these races. Your attention is directed to USTA rule 2, section 8 regarding medication and drugs, which states "all winnings of such horse in a race which an offense was detected under any section of this rule shall be forfeited and paid over to the USTA." This applies to overages of Bute, Flunixin, and Ketoprofen as well as prohibited medications.
- All horses must have current 2018 Coggins test on file with the USTA or the IaHHA Executive Secretary to race in any Iowa Race.
- Any meet that is rained-out will be re-scheduled for the make up dates of October 6 & 7, 2018.
- Any situation not covered by the above rules will be resolved by the Iowa Sires Stakes Association Board of Directors.
