CRITERIA**

1. This scholarship program is provided by the Iowa Harness Racing Association a 501 C 4 organization in support of Iowa harness racing.
2. An Iowa Harness Racing Scholarship applicant, or family member of the applicant, must have a current membership with the Iowa Harness Horsemen's Association.
3. Scholarships will be awarded annually: a high school Senior who has applied/been accepted to a 2-4 year college or trade school for the fall semester of 2024 may apply; and/or a student currently enrolled in college or a trade school may apply. Scholarship payment(s) will be made at the end of a successful semester or term following the scholarship award.
4. Applicants entering a field of study related to equine interests will be given priority.
5. Academic achievement and financial needs will be evaluated.
6. The application period shall run from September 28, through November 1st and the scholarship winners shall be notified before the annual banquet.
7. Scholarship winners and their families will be invited to be special guests of the Iowa Harness Horsemen's Association at the annual USTA Awards Banquet in Urbandale, Iowa, on November 23rd.
8. Please include all pertinent transcripts and grade reports, and be as specific as possible regarding the financial information.
